KNITTING 101: Beginning Knitting

This class is for the Ultimate Beginner or the I-Haven't-Knit-In-Years 'knitter'. All you need are 3 Hershey's Kisses (or comparable treats), a pair of scissors, and your positive attitudes.

REFRESH & REBOOT: Knitting 201

The basics will be covered as well as knitting in the round on circulars and double points, casting on, binding off and reading a pattern. TOE-UP SOCKS ON TWO CIRCULARS

3 Saturdays: September 26, October 3 & 10, 12:30 - 2:30 PM

Class Fee: \$52

One of our most popular classes, the Toe-Up sock technique is for beginner or experienced "sockaholics"! You must know how to cast-on and knit but experience using circular needles is not required. Learn sock construction including the *Magic Cast On* and short rows for making the heel. **Caution:** You might really miss doing the Kitchener Stitch! (NOT!). You will need sock yarn, AND two 24" circular in the appropriate size for your yarn. We can help you with this before class so no worries, please. You *will* have knitting homework between class sessions so plan accordingly. Pattern will be provided.

CROCHET: Beginning and Beyond

Crochet is fun, quick to learn and HOT! Now is the perfect time to learn a new skill or brush up on your rusty ones. Maddie will individualize these two crochet sessions to fit your level and help you with whatever project you want to do. We have some exciting new patterns and luscious yarns. FREE RANGE FELTING

This is NOT needle felting but rather knitting (or crocheting) then throwing your hard work that is super big into your washing machine with hot water and shrinking it. In this class we will help you pick out the perfect tote bag, (or purse) and appropriate yarn. You might want to enroll in the needle felting class (see below) and learn how to add creative surface designs for a truly personal work of art. Technically called "Fulling" it is great fun, addicting and perfect for all skill levels. *Note: This is a good class to practice or learn knitting in the round.*

FANCIFYING YOUR FELTED PROJECTS

Needle felting is fun, versatile and you don't need experience with needles of any kind! This fiber art technique is a creative embellishment to your other knitted items that adds a three-dimensional artistic flair. Bring a felted bag, stocking or tote to decorate (or use a shop provided swatch). **WARNING:** Needle Felting may be addicting and we are total enablers at the shop. Class fee includes a kit for you to keep: foam, 2 needles, roving, and Band-Aids! Instructor: Karen White

SOCKS: Top Down Your Way

3 Mondays: October 19, 26, & November 2, 5:45—7:45 PM **Class Fee: \$52**

In a Yarn Basket's guru will teach you Sock Anatomy, knitting in the round, knitting a heel flap, turning the heel, working a gusset and decreasing for a toe. Your finished project will be one large, colorful sock perfect for a holiday stocking. You choose how you want to knit your socks; double pointed needles or two circular needles. The only prerequisite is you must know how to cast on and knit. We have yarn and the appropriate needle sizes. Stop in before class and make your selections. Remember, all purchases for class materials get a discount of 10%. Pattern provided.

PATTERNED STEEKED SCARF

Here is your chance to learn the technique used in Norwegian-styled sweaters — Steeking. Knit in two colors of Cascade 220 on a US #7 circular needle, it is an unimimidating project for getting comfortable with continental style, knitting in the round and slip stitches while you learn the **STEEK** thing! FELTED SLIPPERS/CLOGS

(Daytime and Evening sessions)

2 Mondays: November 9 & 16, 1:00 — 3:00 PM **OR** 5:45 —7: 45 PM

Class Fee: \$32

These could turn into your most favorite slippers *ever* and you may be knitting & felting them for all your family and friends. Once the method of construction is understood, these clogs are quick and fun. Skills taught are pattern interpretation, knitting in the round, wrap & turns and making stitches. Participants will need a worsted weight wool, US size 13, 24" and 16" circular needles; suede slipper soles are optional but will be available. Class fee includes the pattern. ELEGANT ANYTIME BAG

Wednesday, November 11, 1:00—3:00 PM **OR** Saturday, November 21, 10:30—12:30

Class Fee: \$36

A girl can *never* have (or is that make?) too many purses, bags, totes, or clutches! And this one can be a one ball project. The class fee includes the silk lining and a pattern designed by the instructor. Just choose the yarn — something luscious or practical — whatever speaks to you. These are so much fun, you might not be able to stop at just one and are good for cleaning out your stash. Two 24" circular needles (size-appropriate for your yarn,) and a small crochet hook are needed. Come by the shop and pick out your favorite colored lining; there are many to choose from.

SCANDANAVIAN MITTENS

These gauntlet cuff mittens pull on over jacket sleeves; perfect for the winter blasts. For this class you *must* have some experience with knitting in the round using double pointed needles. Using two contrasting colors of sport weight yarn you will learn the anatomy of a mitten, how to read a chart, and how to secure long floats. MAGIC STRIPED TAM

Here is a single session class on a fun and valuable technique. Using two colors of Cascade 220 and knitting in the round you will learn to change colors so there are no jogs where the stripes join. Pattern by Claire included with class fee.
